

Klipsch Reference Series Gets On-Wall Speakers

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Klipsch announces the Reference Premiere Design On-Wall Speakers, a selection of space efficient speakers designed for rooms with limited floor space ideal for use with wall-mounted flat panel TVs.



The series consists of 4 models-- the small RP-140D, medium RP-240D, large column-style RP-C40D and the RIP-440D SB 3-channel passive soundbar. The first three can be used as left, centre, right or surround speakers, and all models are equipped with 4-way keyholes for horizontal or vertical wall mounting.

Each speaker also includes a glass base installers can attach for placement on a tabletop or bookshelf, with the choice of either horizontal or vertical orientation.

According to Klipsch Tractrix horn technology improves high-frequency response and extension, while enhancing imaging and dynamics. A Linear Travel Suspension titanium tweeter maximises dynamics for detailed performance, while copper Cerametallic woofers minimise distortion while providing one of the highest efficiency ratings in the class.
