Oppo launches the BDT-101CI-- a Blu-ray disc transport designed for the custom install market featuring a modular design suitable for various applications.



Installers get the choice of 1 or 2 HDMI outputs via additional HDMI output module, as well as an HDBaseT output board helpful for long cable runs. In addition Oppo offers a choice of stereo or 7.1-channel analogue audio outputs, as well as an optional rack mount kit. Control comes through RS232, IP and a switchable rear IR sensor allowing for clean IR blaster/emitter installation.

In addition, the front panel features large buttons with finger guards.

The company says AV performance matches that of the previous BDP-103/105, if without the internet apps seen in the consumer-facing models. The player offers 3 customisable picture adjustment presets, and installers can lock settings to prevent unwanted changes.
