Antiference brings a number of recently developed products at ISE 2018, ranging from HDMI distribution to wireless access points and digital modulators.



The wireless access point and extender rabge covers a variety of environments, and is programmable via onboard software designed for use with a laptop, smartphone or tablet. Meanwhile the HDMI range offers more HDCP 2.2-compatible products, including a compact HDBaseT 4x4 matrix for up to 70m and a variety of HDCP 2.2 splitters (available in 2-, 4- and 8-way models).

To complement the hardware, a range of HDMI leads (1, 3 and 5m) is also available, with HDMI certifications.

For an alternative way of HDMI distribution, Antiference offers a number of digital modulators. The line ranges from the entry-level Conexer Simplus (transports Dolby quality sound) to the DMHD01R (incorporates USB playback/record and IR control).
