According to the company myHomeSeer differs from similar services by being able to adjust performance according to user location-- it provides a direct system connection when the user is at home, and shifts to a secure cloud-based connection when one is away.

HomeSeer automation systems are compatible with industry standards and Z-Wave products from the likes of Cooper, Schlage, Kwikset, Baldwin, Yale, GE, Honeywell, Leviton, Linear, Everspring, Evolve, Fibaro, FortrezZ, Aeon Labs and RCS.

The free standard service supports a single HomeSeer system, while the premium version supports up to 5 systems. HomeSeer partners also get an OEM version.

myHomeSeer is currently available in trial form for HS3-based system users, and should go live from May 2014.
