The HDanywhere mHub 2K, mHub 4K and Modular video matrixes are now easier to integrate with Loxone Miniserver and Miniserver Go home automation products, being predefined devices in Loxone Config software (v6.2 and up).



This integration allows the Loxone Miniserver (designed for DIN rail mounting) and Miniserver Go (designed for retrofits) to send IP commands to the HDanywhere matrixes. Thus installers can set macros for customers wanting to turn on multiple AV devices, preset to preferred sources and volume levels, and control lighting, heating and blinds through the Loxone app.

The app can handle both specific room installs or whole home systems. An "AV" category displays a list of rooms with a TV for easy checking of sources playing in which room.

"The ideal scenario was to integrate through IP and we had this up and running in no time," Loxone says. "The IP controls of [HDanywhere's] full range of devices is now built directly into our software, so without any direct wired link, we can integrate the AV distribution system into all of our smart homes."
