Savant Ships Wifi Universal Remote

Savant starts shipping the wifi-based Savant Universal Remote (SUR-0500), a self-configuring number able to control distributed audio, lighting, climate control and other features within homes or small commercial buildings.

First revealed back at CEDIA Expo 2013, the Universal Remote supports a menu of screen for controlling services throughout the home or workplace, and since it uses wifi it requires no line of sight-- meaning users don't need to point or aim it at anything.

Hardware features include a 1.7-inch customisable colour display and 35 back-lit hardware buttons. The remote is capable of 2-way wifi communication, and a RacePoint Blueprint design tool allows for easy customisation.
