

Elan Debuts G1 Control System

Elan introduces a lower-cost control system at CEDIA Expo 2014-- the G1, a controller designed for media rooms, smaller projects, secondary homes, production builder packages and as a handheld universal remote alternative.

The G1 System Controller is configured with 3 IR outputs, 1 IR input, 1 bi-directional RS232 input, 1 sensor, 1 HDMI output and 1 audio output. Built-in wifi allows IP-control, and being PoE enabled it uses less power than conventional controllers.

It also integrates with up to 16 security zones, 2 door locks, media devices (over AVR), 32 displays and an unlimited number of Elan zones. As for home control it handles lighting (24 devices and up to 24 custom G! keypads), climate (3 stats), video (3 IP cameras), irrigation (16 groups and 256 zones) and an unlimited number of Elan and Core Brands attachments.

It ships complete with handheld remote, IR sensor, 3 IR emitters and a serial adapter.
