Sony's Thinnest OLED, New XEL-1

At Display 2008 in Japan, Sony showed a 3.5" OLED with an ultra-thin 0.2mm profile and 320x220 pixel resolution.



Sony also showed a new version of the world's first mass-produced OLED TV, its 11-inch XEL-1. The display panel has a new TFT substrate and less glass, so it can reduce size (0.3mm thick vs current

1.4mm) and keep the same resolution (960x540 pixels).
