

Sony Debuts 4K Home Projector

Sony launches the VPL-VW350ES at CES 2015-- a home theatre projector featuring 4K (4096x2160) native resolution as paired with the company's SXRD™ and Triluminos technologies for further image improvements.

According to Sony SXRD™ panel technology allows for high resolution images without compromises on contrast and fast motion, while the Triluminos optical engine offers "pure, bold colours." Brightness clocks at 1500 lumens, while an additional low latency mode makes the projector ideal for gaming applications.

Further specifications include a 2.06x zoom lens with wide shift range and a built-in RF 3D transmitter. Connectivity comes through HDMI 2.0 and HDCP 2.2, allowing customers to access 4K content from Netflix, Amazon and Sony itself.

The VPL-VW350ES is available from January 2015.
