ZTE presents a wifi-only version of the Spro 2 projector-- a battery-powered portable device able to project live and on-demand video through pre-loaded apps.



It projects 1280x720 resolution images at 120-inches and 200 lumens brightness, with included auto-focus and auto keystone correction. JBL provides audio capabilities, while the 6300mAh battery powers for up to 2.5 hours of projection on a single charge.

Being an Android device it also handles other video streaming and media apps available on the Google Play store, with a bulit-in 5-inch touchscreen providing necessary control. In addition it also handles content from HDMI and USB connections, 64GB micro SD card, Bluetooth and 16GB internal storage.

A built-in Zoom app adds video conferencing and group messaging capabilities.

The Spro 2 was actually released earlier this year, if as an LTE-equipped version doubling as a portable wifi hotspot. As such, ZTE says the latest model is ideal for "consumers who still want the flexibility it provides at home and at work but may not want it added to a new or existing data plan."
