BenQ announces the CineHome HT2050A-- a 1080p home entertainment projector upgrade of the HT2050 featuring a 6x speed RGBRGB colour wheel able to achiever over 96% Rec. 709 accuracy with CinematicColor technology.



The HT2050A is 3D-capable, and comes equipped with two 10W CinemaMaster Audio+ speakers for deeper audio. Low 16.67ms input lag and a special Game Mode make the projector ideal for gaming, while a pair of HDMI ports (HDMI x1, HDMI/MHL x1) allow the connection of a Google Chromecast, Roku or Amazon Fire TV. MHL connectivity allows the streaming of HD content from any MHL-enabled mobile device.

The company says installation is easy, with shorter throw projection capability beaming 100-inch images from as little as 2.4m. Vertical lens shift allows installers to move images up or down without sacrificing quality for easy tabletop setup or mounting, while horizontal and vertical keystone correction eliminates trapezoid effects when projecting from a corner or side table.
