

CEDIA Takes Training to Spain

CEDIA takes EMEA training to Spain for the first time with a 2 day training and networking event for all current and upcoming members in Marbella on 10 November 2015.



The 2 days have a selection of intermediate and advanced training courses, such as the Design and Documentation-- a course detailing documents a successful project requires, from architectural plans, schematics, wiring schedules, change order forms and specifications, to final client sign off.

Another course is Residential Networking, a beginner-level foundation for understanding IP. According to CEDIA the session will leave attendees with a better understanding of common network protocols, the functions of a router in a wired environment and basic troubleshooting of consumer-level IP networks.

Day 2 involves a pair of popular training sessions-- Sub Systems Design and Integration (an in-depth look into the sub-systems making a typical residential install) and Audio, Video and Home Cinema for Installers (an overview of the technical information, basic design principles and installation principles home cinema setups require).

Closing the training sessions is a free Connect with CEDIA networking event providing attendees with a better understanding of CEDIA and membership benefits.

Registration for the Marbella event is open, with early bird discounts available until 31 October 2015.
