

D-Tools and Audiovisions form a joint software development agreement-- one providing D-Tools with access to Audiovisions Pro Integrator IP while Audiovisions gets use of current and future D-Tools software and support.



Audiovisions will also serve an advisory role in the development of future D-Tools System Integrator releases. The goal of the partnership, the two companies say, is to pool resources and brain power into building a next generation of integration software while fuelling future growth.
