The CEDIA Member of Excellence selection process involves rigorous verification of company qualifications in areas including customer service (through 3 customer references from 3 projects within the last 12 months and 2 references from CEDIA Trade Supplier members) and philanthropy (by having either one CEDIA volunteer or at least one CEDIA Outreach Instructor on staff).

The company should also have a percentage (based on size) of full-time technical staff holding at least one CEDIA advanced certification, namely ESC-T, ESC-D or ESC-N Certification (does not include ESC). Finally, the company must be finalist/shortlisted or a CEDIA Award winner within the last 3 years.

Once a company is confirmed as CEDIA Advanced Member or Member of Excellence, they carry the designation through 2 renewal periods. CEDIA is currently accepting awards applications.
