

The HomeKit-Enabled Onelink Safe, Environment Monitor

First Alert presents a variety of HomeKit-enabled home security devices additions to the Onelink portfolio at CES 2016, including a safe, an environment monitor and a smoke alarm.



As one might imagine, users can easily and remotely unlock the Onelink Wifi Safe through an iDevice app or Siri commands, eliminating the need for passcodes. The safe also alerts users of movement or tampering detected through built-in accelerometer, while battery charging comes through USB cable.

Meanwhile the Onelink Environment Monitor is a plug-in unit for the tracking of home temperature and humidity levels. A multi-colour LED ring changes colour according to room conditions, shifting from blue for too cold, amber for too warm and white for correct temperature. In addition the device also tracks carbon monoxide (CO) levels, and lights up in bright red in case of emergency. Being HomeKit-enabled it also pushes notifications to iDevices in case of changes.

Also seen at CES is the Wifi Smoke + CO Alarm-- a 2-in-1 wireless alarm compatible with existing interconnected hardwired alarms. It features a photoelectric smoke sensor promising to reduce false alarms from cooking or shower steam, a 10-year battery and sends alarm notifications to iDevices.
