

A Bluetooth-Enabled Key Box

Master Lock has a connected solution for customers wanting a means to store their spare keys-- the Bluetooth Key Lock Box (model 5441EURD).



The key box is essentially a small safe one can fix to the wall. It opens solely using either a registered smartphone or a correct passcode, and users can manage it via companion iOS/Android Master Lock Vault eLocks app to give contacts access, restrict opening times or lock it down entirely.

Authentication comes via Bluetooth and it doesn't use NFC, meaning users do not need to wave their phone in front of it. The actual box is weatherproof, large enough to hold multiple key cards or traditional keys, and is powered by a battery promising up to 2 years of use.
