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Linear shows off its latest Z-Wave powered product at the New York CES Unveiled event-- the Z-Wave Dimmable LED Light Bulb, an instant-on, screw-in bulb providing soft-white illumination equivalent to a 60W incandescent bulb.



As the name suggests, the bulb is controllable and programmable using any Z-Wave hub or controller. It features 100 dimming levels and a lifespan reaching up to 25000 hours, and in addition acts as a repeater strengthening home Z-Wave mesh networks.

“Our Z-Wave Dimmable LED Bulb clears a major roadblock for lighting control adoption, the need to install high voltage switches,” Linear says. “The smart bulb is the easiest Z-Wave lighting control solution to install, operate and manage, it has the smoothest dimming feature on the market today, and it offers practical applications in nearly every room in a home.”
