

Extending HDMI Through HDBaseT

Aavara launches the PE3D4K100A, a HDBaseT-based HDMI extender system the company says installers can easily retrofit within any existing network.

HDBaseT technology allows it to send HDMI further-- at 1080p 3D with 7.1 channel audio, together with IR control, RS232 and 100Mbps LAN through up to 100m of single Cat5e/6/7 cable.

The receiver receives power over Cat5 cable, and comes with a 3 port hub for LAN extension. The sender/receiver package is DVI 1.0 and HDCP compliant and is ideal for all sorts of installs, from home theatre protectors to multi-room HD AV and internet sharing, as well as other commercial applications.
